

## ASUS AX6100 WiFi 6 ROUTER

### Shipment Content:

- 1 x Protective Case
- 1 x Router with 4 embedded Antennas
- 1 x 9V Power Adapter



### Quick Setup:

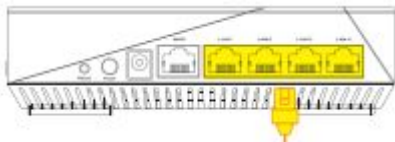
- Plug in the power adapter and a DHCP hard line** from the venue onto the router's **WAN** port. Press the power button on the side to turn on the router. *Allow 3-5 minutes for the router to light up when ready.*



- 5G2, 5G1, 2.4G show that your router is broadcasting WiFi
- WAN (Internet), physical hardline connection established
- Power LED, device is ready

- Lift all 4 antennas** and position them upwards.

- Connect your Wired devices (e.g. Ethernet enabled Printer)** Connect the Ethernet cable to one of the LAN (1-4) ports in the back of the router. Plug the other end of the cable into the printer. *The LAN LED on the router lights up when connected.*



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- Connect your Wireless devices (e.g. Tablet / PC)** Open the camera app on your device and scan the QR-Code on the bottom of the router. Alternatively use the default SSID (Wireless Network Name) on the bottom of the router along with the password in your *Important Documents Folder* to connect wirelessly.

- Via WPS (e.g. WPS enabled Printer)** Press and Hold the WPS button on the side of the router until the Power light starts blinking fast. Then proceed to set the printer on WPS mode as per its setup document. *Allow 1-2 minutes to establish connection.*

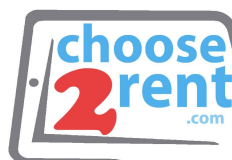
**Please DO NOT press the Reset button on the back of the router.**

### Troubleshooting:

... the router does not power up?	Please check if the power plugs are plugged in tightly. Switch On and Off again. <i>Wait 3 mins.</i>
... the WAN light is RED?	The device is not getting an Internet connection, make sure the hardline is plugged into the router's <b>WAN</b> port. Ask your venue 1) if the venue's hardline has a splash screen, your venue then requires the routers MAC address, it can be found on the bottom of the router 2) verify with the venue that the hardline is <b>DHCP</b> not static.
... the LAN light is OFF?	No physical connection to printer or PC. Make sure the cable is properly plugged in on both ends and the other unit is powered up.
... the 2.4G light is OFF?	Your unit is pre-set to work only on the 5.0GHz wireless connection.
